The year 2013 is the "European Year of Citizens" so this training aims, through its theatre methods and pedagogy, to support European identity and promote European citizens to "Act". Furthermore, it focuses in applying methods that can promote inclusion of marginalized groups (e.g. underrepresented and hard to reach young people with difficulties and disabilities) in the Youth in Action Programme.

The main aims are:

- to create a place to exchange methods and experiences among organizations
- to gain different theatre methods
- exchanging the challenges among organizations working with marginalized target groups in order to overcome barriers
- to support organizations in the development of inclusion projects
- empowering organizations to include marginalized groups within their project work
- designing interactive methods which promote personal development and promote European Identity
- getting new inputs

Furthermore, the training created space to exchange practices, methods and experiences among the organizations as well as share the challenges of those working with marginalized groups in order to learn how to overcome such challenges. The training supported organizations in the implementation and development of inclusion projects and should empower those that aren't working with marginalized groups, to start integrating them in their project work. The training enabled them to design interactive methods, which promote personal development and in doing so support a stronger European Identity. To finalize, the training course gave the organizations the possibility to get new inputs, learn from each other and keep the intercultural differences (but most importantly) as well as similarities in mind.
